In order to best utilize this resource in your congregation, ministry, or personal development, it is important to understand what the *Spiritual Gifts Inventory* is as well as what it is not:

It was designed to:

- 1) Assist the new member or newer believer that is looking for an area of service within the local church body.
- 2) Give an understanding of the many ways the Holy Spirit may empower us for ministry and service.
- 3) Give a basic understanding of others and ourselves in order to allow for more harmonious working relationships.
- 4) Provide a resource that will work in conjunction with teaching and training materials that the local church embraces on the individual gifts.

It was not designed to:

- 1) Be an ***all-inclusive teaching or theological resource*** on the gifts of the Spirit
- 2) Be the ***only*** source the church uses to get believers “plugged in.” In fact, it is the first step in a lifelong process of growing and maturing in the gifting God has given us.

Over the years we have found communication is the key to all relationships. This inventory is all about a relationship; the relationship the believer will have within the local church, and to a greater extent, the relationship within the Body of Christ. ***We cannot stress enough the importance of using this resource as part of a process, one that:***

First: Introduces the purpose of taking *The Spiritual Gifts Inventory* (to help everyone find a place they can serve and are needed).

Second: Provides a follow up with a church leader to discuss the results and help the individual user take the steps necessary to get plugged in.

Third: Continues with a discussion or teaching on the Holy Spirit, the gifts of the Spirit, and the Great Commission!

We pray that this resource will allow your God given vision and ministry to expand through the involvement of committed, gifted, and encouraged believers who are under your care.
